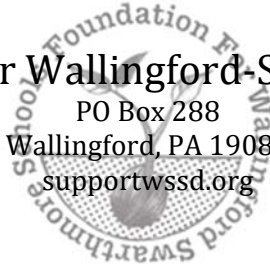

Beyond these highlighted grant awards and major projects, the Foundation also supported the purchase of calculators and organizational tools for underprivileged students and the payments of stipends for college students to participate in elementary school homework clubs.

FOUNDATION'S MISSION

The mission of the Foundation for Wallingford-Swarthmore Schools is to support innovation and excellence in the Wallingford-Swarthmore School District, and to enhance the quality of public education by engaging the support and energies of educators, parents, students, alumni and the greater community.

NEED FOR AN EDUCATION FOUNDATION

- For the 2015-2016 school year, school districts are facing less state funds and local tax revenues. The cut in funding for our school districts means less money available to spend on our children and reduced learning opportunities.
- In response to these cuts, a group of committed parents have been working to establish the Foundation to obtain supplemental funding to support.
- The Foundation is working to develop relationships and partnerships with individuals including alumni who will assist us on targeted fundraising efforts such as science, music, arts, foreign language.
- As a 501(c)(3) nonprofit corporation, the Foundation has been working with private foundations and corporations to obtain donations, as well as, actively pursuing funding from government sources (local, state and federal).

ACCOMPLISHMENTS TO DATE

- Since January 2011, the Foundation has established a Board of Directors and a dedicated group of volunteers along with obtained 501(c)(3) tax exempt status.
- The Foundation participates in the United Way Program (**donor code: 49418**) and with the Amazon Smile Program (<http://smile.amazon.com/ch/23-2608455>).
- The Board members and volunteers have worked hard to ensure that solid groundwork is in place to review and award grants for innovative learning opportunities, work with the school district teachers and administration to identify the students' needs and obtain funds to support these needs.

CURRENT EVENTS AND PROJECTS

- By the end of January 2012, the Foundation awarded approximately \$10,000 to support innovative programs for teachers. In addition, the Grants Committee reviewed the applications to determine larger funding initiatives. In addition, by the end of December 2012, the Foundation awarded over \$12,500 in additional grants to benefit the WSSD students and teachers. Several of these grants awarded have a district-wide impact.
- In June 2013, the Foundation announced the initial funding in the amount of \$22,000 to support two major initiatives to benefit WSSD students – a **Classroom Libraries Initiative** to successfully institute “book clubs,” “reading workshops,” and “literature circles” in classrooms and a comprehensive **Middle School Robotics Program** to provide students with early exposure to STEM topics.
- In May 2014, the Foundation fully funded the comprehensive **Middle School Robotics Program**, a \$30,000 initiative, and in May 2015, the Foundation fully funded the **Classroom Libraries Initiative**, a \$46,000 initiative, with funds received from Arts4Smarts.
- The Foundation successfully held its 5th annual **Panther Pajama Run and Pancake Breakfast** to increase awareness of the Foundation on November 7, 2015 and to fund its **Teacher Grants Program**.
- The Signature Event Committee of the Foundation held a successful **Arts4Smarts** silent auction and wine and cheese in order to fundraise and increase awareness for the Foundation on March 7, 2015 – www.arts4smarts.org and is preparing for its annual **Arts4Smarts** signature event to be held this March 5, 2016.
- The Foundation has successfully partnered with groups across the District to support specific funding requests.
